Business Exposure & Community Betterment through Tourism & Economic Development Initiatives

The Chamber leads tourism strategies and works closely with county and state partners to showcase Decorah's amazing amenities and businesses. In 2022, the Chamber was a champion for capacity building, increased collaboration, and marketing specificity.

Highlights for 2022:

The Chamber has played a lead role in the planning and welcoming of Viking Cruises. In 2022 staff worked with area restaurants, crafted a bus guide narrative in cooperation with Vesterheim Museum, and will co-host three Shore Excursions.

Inclusion in the State's Soul of Iowa NATIONAL marketing campaign which was launched in the spring of 2022 and runs through year end. As one of the four featured communities, Decorah receives far-reaching benefits.

The Chamber serves as Treasurer for the Hotel/Motel Marketing Committee and works to leverage/match fund dollars into larger more impactful projects. The Chamber also ensures the committee goals are implemented successfully. They include:

The Chamber was awarded an Iowa Tourism Marketing Grant to complete a series of promotional videos that blend visitor and resident experience. These are being filmed now and will be used by the Chamber, WCDT, Visit Decorah, partners, and businesses.

The Chamber submitted two area businesses for awards and they were selected as state winners: Driftless Yoga Festival – *Outstanding Diversity, Equity, & Inclusion Initiative* and Luna Valley Farm – *Outstanding Attraction (Rural)*

The Chamber manages and staffs the Decorah Visitor Center to serve the thousands of tourists annually.

Connecting Agriculture & the Business Community

The Chamber has long worked to keep local agriculture and local business connected. Highlights for 2022: The Steak & Shake Drive-Thru served in June and the Annual Stay Safe, Take a Break Event will take place in October. This year it will thank 180 farmers/farm families in the NE Quadrant of Winneshiek County.

The Chamber's Ag. Committee provides scholarships to high school students and helps judge the Herdsmanship Award at the Winneshiek County Fair.

Chamber Director Rilling served as a Judge for the Northeast District FFA Competition.

The Chamber supports Decorah Farmers Market and Farmers Market Board to leverage resources and cultivate entrepreneurship for growers and producers in NE Iowa.

Representing the Decorah Business Community

The Chamber has represented the community at local, state, and regional economic development gatherings to network, collaborate, and plug Decorah into

opportunities including the Iowa Rural Summit, Iowa Downtown Conference, Iowa Tourism Conference, and Empower Rural Iowa Task Force Decorah Meeting. Chamber Director Rilling presented at the Rural Iowa Summit on the Empower Decorah Leadership Program at the request of Ltd. Governor Gregg.

Ensuring a Robust Online Presence for Businesses

The Chamber knows that Decorah's presence online is key to business recruitment, business viability, and business reputation

The Chamber provides a website platform for its members which boosts individual business SEO and enhances marketing. Staff are working on a new chamber website which will go live in 2023. The new site has a more modern look and feel and has improved features.

The Chamber secured a USDA Rural Business Development Grant in July 2022. This grant will support work that ensures the Decorah and WInneshiek County's online business and attraction content is accurate and works for the benefit of the businesses and the community.
